Activity	Executive Order No. 8- 2021 <i>Takes effect as of March 12, 2021 at 5:00 p.m</i>
<b>Amusement Parks</b>	50%
<b>Banquet Halls, Receptions and Meeting Room in Hotels, Conference Centers and Similar Establishments</b>	No more than 50% maximum capacity applicable to the specific room where event will be held
<b>Bars, Nightclubs, and Adult Entertainment</b>	No changes
<b>Bingo Halls</b>	50%
<b>Bowling Alleys</b>	50%
<b>Car Washes</b>	No changes
<b>Casinos &amp; Gaming Facilities</b>	50%
<b>Childcare</b>	No changes
<b>Cigar Bars/Hookah Bars/Vape Shops</b>	50%
<b>Concert Venues</b>	50%
<b>Day Camps</b>	No changes
<b>Face Coverings</b>	No changes
<b>Farmer's Market</b>	No changes
<b>Funeral Homes</b>	50% maximum capacity applicable to each visitation/viewing room

<b>Gyms, Fitness Centers, &amp; Other Indoor Physical Activities</b>	50%
<b>Indoor and Outdoor Pools (public and private)</b>	50%
<b>Indoor Skating Rinks (roller and ice skating)</b>	50%
<b>Large Gatherings (Indoors and Outdoors)</b>	<p><b>Indoor gatherings</b> maximum of 20 persons—whichever is lower (Indoor locations and venues, include but not limited to: private residences, parades, festivals, conventions, and fundraisers)</p> <p><b>Outdoor gatherings</b> maximum of 50 persons—whichever is lower (Outdoor locations and venues, include but not limited to: private residences, parades, festivals, conventions, and fundraisers)</p>
<b>Manufacturing</b>	No changes
<b>Miniature Golf</b>	No changes
<b>Outdoor Recreational Activities</b>	No changes
<b>Personal Services (beauty salons, barber shops, tattoo parlors, massage parlors etc.)</b>	<p><b>Barbershops and Beauty Salons:</b> Appointment only; Customers are not allowed to congregate in common sitting area waiting to be served; Use of PPE, including face coverings and gloves, by all employees; 50% of maximum capacity</p> <p><b>Other Personal Services</b> (esthetic and nail services, tattoo services, tanning, massages, hot tub and sauna services): Appointment only; Use of PPE, including face coverings and gloves, by all employees; or 50% of maximum capacity</p>
<b>Places (Houses) of Worship</b>	<p>Indoor 50%</p> <p>May have outdoor services up to 50% maximum capacity of outdoor area, if maintain appropriate social distancing of at least 6 feet between persons of different households and have access to hand washing/hand sanitizers. Frequent hand washing/hand sanitizing encouraged.</p>
<b>Pool Halls</b>	50% of maximum capacity; Pool sticks, racking equipment and balls must be sanitized between games.

<b>Professional and Collegiate Sporting Events</b>	50% of max. capacity Tailgating is prohibited
<b>Recreation Facilities (Indoor)</b>	50% of maximum capacity
<b>Restaurants</b>	Indoor – 50% max capacity Outdoor – 50% max capacity
<b>Retail (Grocery Stores, Specialty Food Stores, Big Box, Shopping Malls, et.)</b>	50% max capacity
<b>Senior Centers</b>	No changes
<b>Social and Fraternal Clubs</b>	50% max capacity
<b>Theaters</b>	50% max capacity
<b>Tour Boats</b>	50% (no change)
<b>Youth and Amateur Sports (excluding schools per Governor’s order)</b>	All sports are categorized by level of risk (low, medium, high). May resume in small groups, no more than 22 team members. Low and medium risk sports, to include competition, are allowed as listed. The play of high-risk sports is prohibited; however, practice that involves skills-building and drills are permitted outdoors.  The number of spectators is limited. Number of persons present (apart from players and coaches) may not exceed 50 persons. The number of persons present may exceed 50 solely to accommodate the presence of no more than two parents or guardians per youth participant
<b>Other Nonessential Businesses</b>	50% max capacity
